What are the entry requirements?

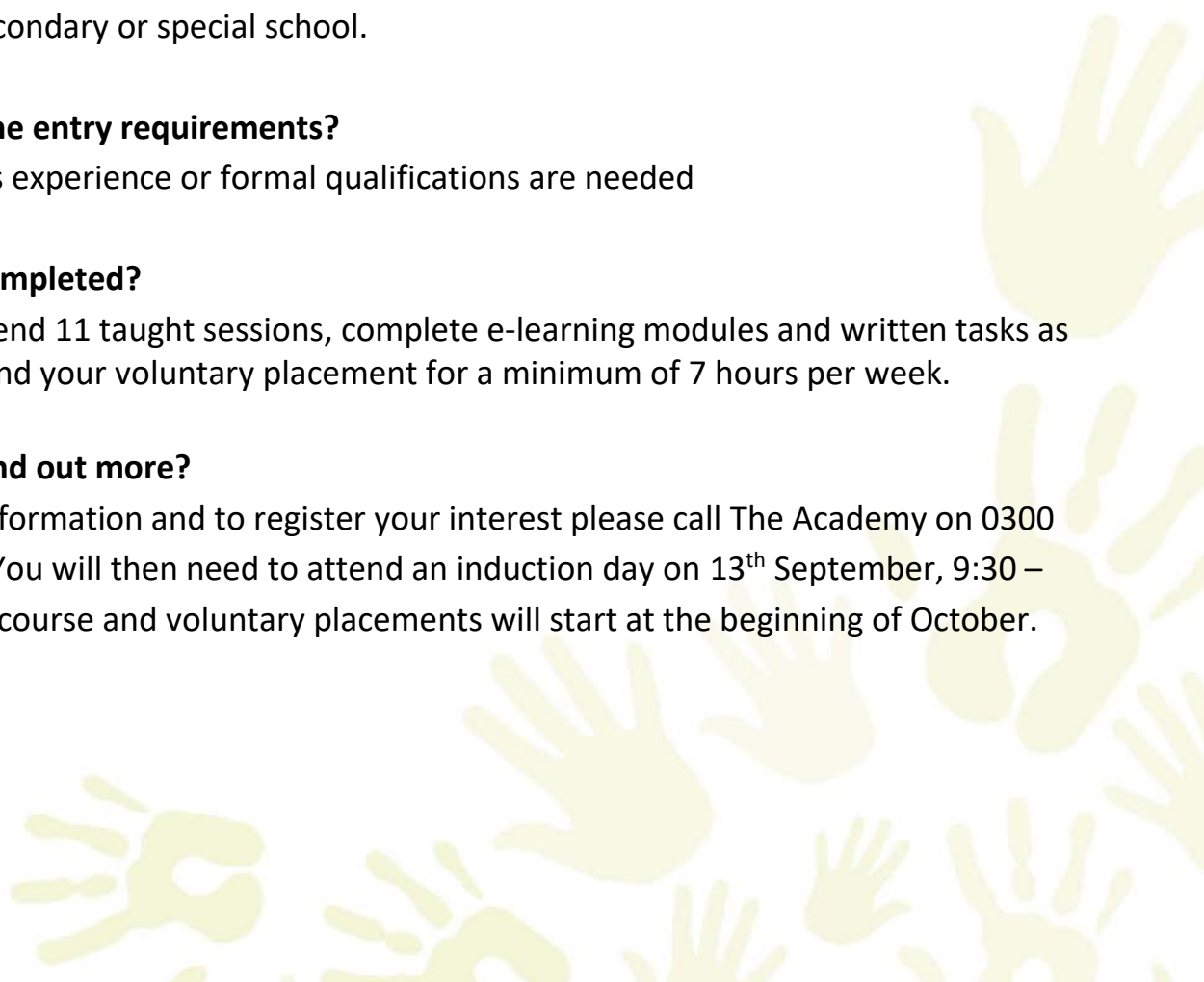
No previous experience or formal qualifications are needed
