YEAR 6 ENTERPRISE WEEK - 27TH AND 1ST JUNE 2016

During Summer 2, Year 6 will be taking part in a Young Enterprise project. As part of this work, arrangements have been made for Year 6 to set up and run their own small businesses running from **Monday 27th June to Friday 1st July.**

This event has been a fantastic opportunity for pupils to learn about running a successful business and ways to promote a community event.

So far the children have set up the following businesses:

- WARter Balloon - Water balloon battles.
- Fantastic Fruit Fantics - Selling fruit kababs, watermelon cubes, fruit salads and chocolate strawberries.
- Hit a Balloon - Using NERF guns to hit balloons for prizes.
- Randon Inc. - Selling Loom Bands and bouncy balls, and running a 'Guess how many sweets are in the jar', as well as a Penalty shootout for prizes.
- Shamani and Dayana's Sweet Bouquets - Selling bouquets of sweets and offering strawberry and marshmallow chocolate fountain.
- Bubble Wash - Washing cars.
- Lewis and Anish's Snacks and Drinks - Selling cookies, fizzy drinks and juice.
- Drink Fizzy - Selling fizzy drinks.
- Luscious Lips - Selling lip scrubs.
- Rainbow Fruit Twist - Selling fruit kebabs and ice pops.
- Slime 'n' Grime - Selling coloured/sparkling slime.
- Sweets and Treats - Selling cups of sweets and running a 'Guess the code to unlock the prize'.
- Carnival Corn - Selling cones of popcorn and running Carnival games for prizes.

Throughout the week each group will be allocated a time and given the opportunity to set up and run their business during break and lunchtime. Also, at **1:30 - 3:30pm on Wednesday 29th June**, the school will be holding an 'Enterprise Afternoon' where parents, guardians, family members, members of the community etc. are invited into school to give the children further opportunities to run their businesses.

We kindly ask you to allow your children to bring a small amount of money into school each day during this week to allow them to support the Year 6 children in their enterprise project.

All money raised during this will either be invested back into Year 6 or donated to charity, depending on what each business chose.
