Dear Parents/Carers

We are pleased to be able to offer Bikeability courses to Years 5 & 6 pupils during the week commencing 10th October during school time.

Bikeability is a national scheme organised and operated by trained professionals aimed at improving a child's confidence and ability on their bicycle. It teaches pupils how to ride safely to and from school. It is open to all pupils who have access to a roadworthy bicycle and a cycle helmet. The course is run over four days, with pupils completing two hour sessions per day.

Pupils should already be able to ride and control their bikes. Session 1 takes place on the playground, and fun games and activities are used to teach basic bike skills such as looking behind and signaling. The children then progress to following a planned route around roads near the school. Here they will watch, discuss, then practice a variety of cycling maneuver's using different road situations. All sessions must be attended because the skills build up gradually.
